### EXAMINATION POLICY

Class V and below will keep following the 5-test schedule which will be conducted in the month of July, September, November, December and February carrying 20% weightage.

## **FOR CLASS VI to VIII**

- (i) There will be four tests of 10% each in the month of May, July, November and December respectively.
- (ii) The two main examinations of 30% each will be held in the month of August and February respectively.
- (iii) The four tests and the two examinations will be summed up for making the final results out of 100%.
- (iv) To be promoted to the next class a student requires a minimum of 40% in every subject.

## **FOR CLASS IX TO XII**

For class IX to XII CBSE the examination pattern is same i.e., four tests of 10% each and two main examinations, the students of class X appear in examinations on the Question Papers sent by the board, and for class XII students, the board conducts the examinations as in the past.

For class IX to XII CISCE the examination policy will remain the same as VI to VIII except that for class X (ICSE) and XII (ISC) students will appear in the board examination.

It is compulsory to pass the School conducted pre-boards to appear in the Board Examination.

### **NOTE :THE FIRST TEST FOR CLASS XI WILL BE HELD IN THE MONTH OF JULY 2016**

The half yearly examination for classes VI and above will commence tentatively from 29<sup>th</sup> Aug'16, Monday. Classes Nursery to V will have their monthly tests as per schedule mentioned in the Collegiate Diary. Kindly ensure that your ward is pursuing his/her studies regularly. All parent teacher meetings must be attended by every parent, it helps the student to perform better.

The result of half yearly examination will be declared during the parent teacher meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> Sept '15 i.e. Saturday. Timings – Sharda Nagar 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and Jopling Road from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. No student is allowed to carry his report card home. The parents are required to personally see and sign the card when they attend the parent teacher meeting at the end of each examination. The report card of each child is kept in their personal files. In this way we are able to maintain a complete record of the child's performance. This system has been greatly appreciated by the board.

Parents are expected to co-operate with the Collegiate authorities and the teachers by enforcing upon their wards regularity, punctuality and neatness. The note books and lessons must also be regularly supervised. The students must be encouraged to take active part in the collegiate activities and inter-house competitions. Do ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform and that his/her note-books are signed by you as and when asked by the teachers. It is compulsory for the students to wear the identity card.

If a student is unable to attend the school a leave application must be submitted to the Principal. **SHORT LEAVE OR HALF DAYS LEAVE IS NOT PERMITTED.**

Parents are requested to make sure that no student carries a mobile phone to school. The phones once confiscated will not be returned. Students are strictly prohibited from using scooters, motor cycles and cars for commuting to and fro to school unless they possess a valid driving license and helmet. Strict action will be taken against the defaulters.

The Collegiate has the SMS-Alert system and you must be receiving the messages from the collegiate- **LPCJRB** for Jopling Road and **LPCSNB** for Sharda Nagar branch. Kindly ensure that the mobile number provided by you is correct for receiving the messages.

Any change in residential address or phone number must immediately be communicated to the school authorities.
