03. Timings for Day-Boarding : 08:45 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Day School : 08:45 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.
04. (A) **For the New Academic Session**: - In case any parent is desirous of transferring their ward either from **Sharda Nagar to Jopling Road** or Vice-Versa, kindly apply in writing to the office latest by **16th March 2026**.
(B) In case any parent wishes a change in nature from a Day-Scholar/Day-Boarder or Boarder must apply latest by **16th March 2026**. The above changes mentioned in point 4 (A) and (B) are permissible from the beginning of the new session for the entire session. No changes are permitted in mid-session.
05. Class group photographs will be taken on 28th & 29th Jan'2026. Students must be present in complete winter uniform on these days.
06. The Annual Examination and Unit Tests are to commence tentatively from **14th Feb'2026**. Kindly help your ward to perform better in this examination, regular mathematics practice and learning work must be done at home, for any assistance kindly do not hesitate to approach us.
07. **There will be a Parent Teacher Meeting on 10th January, 2026 between 09:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.**
08. Kindly ensure that your ward comes to school in proper & correct uniform. If a student is unable to attend the school, a leave application must be submitted to the Principal. In case of illness a proper medical certificate must be attached with the leave application. Short-leave or half day leave is not permitted.
09. Parents are requested to ensure that no student carries mobile phone to school or wears smart watches. The phones once confiscated will not be returned.
